Florida Public Libraries supported 4,353 jobs in their communities beyond 6,450 library staff positions.



Library spending meant nearly \$180 million in earnings for local workers, in addition to \$374 million for library staff.

During FY2021-22, the percentage of total costs for the Library Data and Statistics Program financed with federal money is 66%; the federal dollar amount to be spent on the program is \$158,599. This program does not receive any non-governmental funding.
