

Use of Electronic Materials

Defined as circulation of E-Books, electronic video, and audio files that are checked out.

Up 25% from 2019, 50% over 5 years



Retrieval of Electronic Content

Defined as documents or other items viewed or downloaded that don't require checkout.

Up 21% from 2019, 186% over 5 years

During FY2021-22, the percentage of total costs for the Library Data and Statistics Program financed with federal money is 66%; the federal dollar amount to be spent on the program is \$2158,599. This program does not receive any non-governmental funding.
