The Problem

- Lack of infrastructure within Washington County for reliable internet
- Cost prohibitive internet in areas where available
- Low socioeconomic patron base
- More people needing internet to do everyday tasks
 - Fill out job applications
 - Do homework
 - Apply for e-government services

The Project

Providing wifi hotspots to library patrons with no access or limited access to internet throughout Washington County.



Preparing for problems

Rules

- Each library location receives a certain number of hotspots for circulation
- Wifi hotspot comes preloaded with 1GB of data
- Checkout time is 21 days

Regulations

- Must be a Washington County resident
- Must have had your library card for 1 year
- Asked to fill out a survey after returning

Providing the Solution

- Bought Straight Talk wifi hotspots from local Wal-Mart
 - Price- \$99.00 each
- Bought 1GB data cards from local Wal-Mart
 - Price- \$15.00 each
- Bought plastic sandwich containers from Dollar Tree
 - Price- \$1.00 each
- Called and activated devices
 - Time- approximately 15 minutes each
- Cataloged devices
 - Time- approximately 1 hour
 - Cost- sweet tea from McDonald's for cataloger

Possibilities from the Project



- Loaning out equipment only and allowing patrons to provide their preferred level of data
- Utilizing hotspots for library outreach events
- Providing hotspots for teachers to use
- Providing hotspots for government entities for outreach or travel
