

Template for Provisional Ballot Voter's Certificate and Affirmation (DRAFT)

Instructions for the Voter

1. Complete and sign this Provisional Ballot Voter's Certificate and Affirmation in front of election official
2. Give the certificate to the election official to witness and obtain your Notice for Provisional Ballot Voter.
3. Vote your provisional ballot in secret (use marksense ballot or a voter interface device to make your choices).
4. After voting, put the ballot or voter-verifiable paper output with your choices into a secrecy envelope or sleeve and then place the secrecy envelope or sleeve into a provisional ballot envelope.
5. Seal the provisional ballot envelope and place in the appropriate ballot box.

Procedures for Election Official at Polling Location Only:

1. Have the voter complete the Provisional Ballot Voter's Certificate and Affirmation.
2. Witness the voter's signature and complete the "Election Official" section of the Certificate.
3. Check reason(s) for provisional ballot:
 - Voter did not provide picture and/or signature identification.
 - Voter's ID signature and signature in person do not appear to match but voter refuses to complete affidavit at the polls.
 - Voter's FI DL #, FI ID card # or SSN has not been verified as indicated on precinct register.
 - Voter's identity is in question based on photo ID.
 - Voter's name does not appear on the precinct register and voter's eligibility cannot be verified but voter maintains eligibility.
 - Voter refuses to execute address change update.
 - Voter is a move in from another county and cannot make an address change effective at the polls (applies only to polling place without electronic precinct register).
 - Voter who requested vote-by-mail ballot wants to vote in person although the voter's vote-by-mail ballot has been received.
 - Voter who requested vote-by-mail ballot wants to vote in person but the supervisor's office cannot confirm receipt of the voter's vote-by-mail ballot.
 - Voter wants to vote although voter may have already voted.
 - A written challenge has been filed against the voter. (attach copy of challenge)

 - Extended Hours Only:* Vote cast after 7 p.m. due to extended hours pursuant to court or other order extending the hours.

4. Give the voter the Notice of Rights for Provisional Ballot Voters
5. Issue the voter a provisional ballot, secrecy envelope, and this Certificate envelope.
6. Instruct voter to place provisional ballot envelope in ballot box after voting.

Investigative Findings:

Procedures for Canvassing Board:

1. Review all information to determine whether voter is registered, voted in correct precinct, and did not already cast a ballot in the election.
2. Review voter's certificate and affirmation, and if applicable, the cure affidavit and accompanying supporting documentation, other evidence provided by voter, and evidence by challenger.
3. If signature not already verified as valid by the Supervisor of Elections' office, compare the signature on the certificate and affirmation, or the provisional ballot cure affidavit with the signature on the voter's registration or precinct register to determine match. In the case of a cure affidavit, the supporting Tier 1 or Tier 2 ID must also confirm voter's identity in order to count the ballot. If signature on cure affidavit does not match, a current and valid Tier 1 ID confirming identity is acceptable to count ballot, if voter otherwise eligible.

A majority of the board is required to find that signatures do not match and beyond a reasonable doubt.
