Renovation and New Construction ARTSE CULTURE Attachments Checklist

Attachments are required documentation for eligibility.

The required attachments for Cultural Facilities **Renovations and New Construction** are:

- 1. Matching Funds Documentation (include a list or spreadsheet with totals with documentation)
 - Bank statements, awards, contracts, for cash on hand
 - Copies of irrevocable pledges
 - Letters and/or invoices from in-kind contributors
- 2. REDI Waiver Request Letter (for REDI Waiver requests only)
- 3. Documentation of Unrestricted Use
 - Deed, title, property tax statement to document unrestricted use, OR
 - Executed copy of lease and written explanation of any easements, covenants, or other conditions to document unrestricted use. Highlight within the document and/or indicate the page number where the term or expiration date is located in a cover letter. Owner can only be not-for-profit or municipality.
- 4. Total Support and Revenue Documentation
 - Audit or financial statement
 - Audit or financial statement of the organization that will be responsible for management of the facility (public entity applicants only)
- 5. Current Architectural Plans certified by a licensed architect or engineer (If architectural plans are not required for project, contractor project proposals or working drawings must be provided.)
- 6. Project Support Documentation
 - Up to 6 current letters of support from local officials (City and County Government), community groups, and community members
- 7. Bureau of Historic Preservation (BHP) Determination Letter (for buildings 50 years or older). This includes structures where the intent is demolition.
- 8. Not-for profit tax exempt applicants must provide a copy of your IRS 5O1(c) (3) or 5O1(c) (4) determination letter
- 9. Current Substitute W-9. A copy can be obtained at <u>https://flvendor.myfloridacfo.com</u>
- 10. Mission and Programming Materials such as season program, box office statement, educational programs that document cultural programming of facility (If project is for a NEW space without previous programming, provide programming examples.)

Additional Support Materials: Support materials may be considered in the review and scoring so including them is highly recommended.
